You may remember from before the Burrell closed in 2016 that we ran a really popular programme called "Curators Favourites" that allowed curators (and sometimes students) to share new and interesting research on a current favourite object or just have a chance to talk passionately about an object that they loved.

I am bringing this back as part of the new adult programme and after consultation with the curators have decided to rebrand and expand. Now called **Burrell Bites** I would like to invite **all** Burrell staff, students and volunteers to share a favourite with our visitors.

## The format will be:

- the speaker doing a short talk about their chosen object, in front of the object so it must be on display at the Burrell.
- It is intended to be short between 10 20 mins is fine and be ready for some questions.
- You can come at it from any angle biographical, conservation, interesting provenance, hidden history, how it is made

I would also kindly ask that as you are doing your prep for this short talk that you also complete a Burrell Object info Sheet (attached). This means that your object becomes part of our object info pack for staff and volunteers and that your research is used in a few different ways. It also means that the Burrell staff who cannot make your talk for operational reasons do not miss out.
