Sir William Conyers fought at Flodden and was Constable of Richmond and Middleha
Castles. He refurbished Hornby Castle and built the portal. Created Baron 1509.

Lord DACRE

John, 3rd Lord m. Lady Mary Clifford
Two sons died

Elizabeth m. Thomas DARCY 2nd son of Sir Arthur Darcy descendant of John Darcy #

Conyers, 7th Lord Darcy de Knayth and 4th Lord Conyers
co-heir to the Baronies of Fauconberg, Darcy (de Knayth), Meinell and Conye
through his mother, and in addition heir male of the House of Darcy through
his father.
