| ATON | : Or, a cross passant sable |
| ST QUINTON | : Or, a chevron gules, a chief vair |
| NEVILL
of Hornby | : Argent, a saltire gules |
| NEVILL
Earl of Westmorland | : Gules, a saltire argent |
| DARCY
de Knayth | : Azure, crusily and three cinquefoils argent |
| DARCY * | : Argent, three roses gules |
| MEINILL | : Azure, two gemelles and a chief or |
| FAUCONBERG | : Or, a fess azure, in chief three palets gules |
| FAUCONBERG | : Argent, a lion rampant azure |
| DACRE * | : Gules, three escallops argent |
