- A Small Selection -

NEVILLE of Hornby	: Argent, a saltire gules, a label of three points argent
EDWARD the CONFESSOR	: Azure, a cross patonce between five martlets or
The SEE of WINCHESTER	: Gules, two keys addorsed or in bend sinister
STOURTON	: Sable, a bend or between six fountains (Classic example of canting arms, representing (perhaps) the six springs of the River Stoure which rose three inside and three outside Stourton Park).
HOLFORD	: Argent, a greyhound sable
?	: Per fess gules and vert, three hedgehogs proper
DE VERE	: Quarterly gules and or, in the first quarter a mullet argent
CLARE	: Or, three chevrons gules
ST JOHN	: Gules, two bars argent, a canton ermine
BAGOT	: Argent, s chevron gules between three martlets sable
